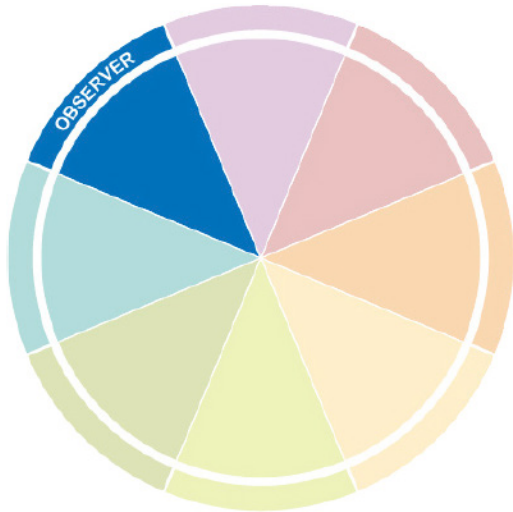


A Snapshot of your Working Styles
